At Ross Memorial Hospital, technology does more than save time—it saves lives.

As a surgeon, I see it happen every day.

I recently witnessed it while operating on an elderly patient's fractured hip. Everything was going perfectly, and then I heard the anaesthetist: "Ali, STOP."

She was seeing abnormal signals on the anaesthetic gas machine that was delivering the patient's sedative and monitoring her breathing, heart rate and other vital signs.

The patient's heart was failing.

Thanks to the early warning provided by the patient monitoring technology, we were able to safely stop the surgery to resuscitate and regulate her heart with a pacemaker.

Having the right technology in the operating room made it possible to deal with a potentially life-threatening problem before it was an emergency.

Surgeons and anaesthetists work together to make sure each patient's surgery is successful and safe. The hospital's anaesthetic gas machines are a vital part of that vigilance.

Their advanced display and alarm system allow the anaesthetist to customize the workstation for each patient, meaning the right information is presented at the right time to help us react even quicker to changes in the patient's status.

Anaesthetic gas machines are the most important piece of patient safety equipment in the OR.
