We have the *original donor wall* at the Angeline Street entrance and we now have a *new donor wall* as part of our new main lobby.

These walls serve as an inspiration for others to continue with the Tradition of Giving we have witnessed from this community.

In 1902, James Ross built Ross Memorial Hospital as a legacy to his parents and as a donation to his community.

Local artist and paper sculptor Calvin Nicholls' inspiration is integral to the design of both of our walls and certainly adds a special and unique touch. It symbolizes the vision launched in 1902 by James Ross that is sustained through the on-going generosity of our community.

Continue the Tradition

Benefactor	\$ 20,000
Patron	\$ 50,000
Founder	\$ 100,000

You may specify the way in which you wish to have your name, your company's name and the purpose of your gift inscribed on the plaque.

Recognition is based on accrued lifetime giving and your level of recognition will be accommodated as you continue to make contributions to Ross Memorial Hospital.
